I. Mural update and timeline

- d. Location: Front quad

B. December 2020 Art Auction results: Goal, \$2,500 (½ the price of mural), 45 artists Donated, 60 pieces of art sold, Monday raised \$2,166 (auction) + \$550 Go Fund Me=\$2,716!!!

1. Most people have picked up their art pieces. About 8 people still need to pick up items.

II. Principals Update

A. Annual budget survey: Lindsey Mozer will submit feedback to the district accountability committee to submit to the PSD Board of Education for the 21/22 school year.

1. We suffered budget problems b/c of less students thus less tax revenue. We predict another cut is coming.
2. We need to know what our priorities will be understanding that we'll still be in a Pandemic this fall.

B. 4 questions:

1. Professional Development: What will teachers need to know how to do? What are budget priorities (all significant needs)?
 - a. Pandemic for teachers to learn from each other. Inter teacher learning

- b. Mental health for teachers and students
- c. High impact/high growth strategies to catch up in reading, math, and language acquisition

C. Staffing: Before a student based budgeting system was used. Each student was allotted an amount which caused Elementary schools to suffer but not secondary schools.

- 1. Special needs, Occupational Therapy, Speech, Gifted and Talented
- 2. Long term subs
 - a. Good pay and benefits for subs
- 3. More support staff/family liaison type positions and/or resources
- 4. More resources for teaching Spanish
- 5. Tutors
- 6. Small group intervention
- 7. Help line/online for evening/weekend help and technical support

D. Facility needs: remodels furnishing, other fiscal needs that need to be addressed

- 1. Gymnasium
- 2. furniture for social distancing
- 3. Outdoor classroom
- 4. Awnings over main walkway and parent pick-up areas
- 5. Permanent contract with cell companies for mifi in high needs households. Before Verizon and T-Mobile. Those contracts end in March.
